A seal of approval. A badge of belonging. A quiet invitation to something special.


And a signature.





























CAPELONGUE

THE PROVENCAL ART OF LIVING, REIMAGINED

High above the village of Bonnieux, Capelongue unfolds like a hidden hamlet, tucked between sky and lavender fields.

LE MOULIN

THE SUMMER HOUSE

Hidden behind centuries-old trees in the heart of Lourmarin, Le Galinier feels like arriving at a friend's house deep in the countryside; if that friend happened to have an 18th-century bastide surrounded by three hectares of gardens.

This is the Provence we don't talk about enough. The one shaped by literature, crafts, shared meals, and time spent doing very little at all. Sheltered from the rush of modern life, Le Galinier offers a chance to slow down and settle in, with spaces designed for both solitude and togetherness. Each corner of the house, from its sun-dappled patios to its charming salons, carries the feeling of a place that's cherished.

Here, the days stretch long and the landscape opens wide toward the Petit Luberon.



LES ROCHES ROUGES

LIFE ON THE RIVIERA

There's a particular shade of blue here; somewhere between sky and sea that lingers in your memory long after you've left. Set between the pines and tamarisk trees of the Esterel coast, Les Roches Rouges is a 1950s modernist icon, rooted in the rhythm of the Mediterranean.

This is where you come to let go. To swim in seawater, sunbathe without a watch, linger over long lunches, and feel the salt dry on your skin. The scent of pine mingles with the sea breeze, and every space; from the open-air cinema to the garden spilling down to the shore, is designed for living outside.

Here, summer stretches endlessly, and the only rule is to do what feels good.

PETUNIA

AN INTIMATE HIDEAWAY

There's a moment at Petunia; perhaps at sunset, when the sky blushes and the silhouette of Es Vedrà emerges like a legend, when time seems to pause. Tucked away on the quiet side of Ibiza, Petunia offers something rare: peace. Surrounded by lush gardens, with the sea always in view, this is where simplicity meets soul.

Nature takes the lead here. Whitewashed walls, sun-warmed wood, and woven textures let the light in and the mind wander. The days unfold slowly; breakfast in the garden, a swim, a moment of stillness under the olive trees. Then an aperitivo on the rooftop, watching the horizon shimmer.

At Petunia, you're not just on the island. You become part of its myth.

Perched at 1,274 metres above sea level, Grand Hotel Belvedere is more than a hotel. Set across two storied buildings, Waldrand and Belvedere, the hotel is a tribute to Bernese craftsmanship, reimagined for the modern traveller. 
