In a postcard-perfect Provence, the 5* Capelongue hotel unfolds on the edge of the Claparèdes plateau, facing the village of Bonnieux, like a preserved hamlet of the Luberon. Surrounding its central square with a fountain, rooms and suites, a Michelin-starred restaurant, gardens, a spa, a swimming pool, and a lap pool promise exceptional stays. Located just 40 minutes from Avignon and an hour from Marseille, open year-round, Capelongue is the confidential refuge for lovers of untamed nature and the laid-back southern lifestyle.

An ideal holiday destination where escape takes shape along the Luberon trails or in the tranquility of a suspended moment, with a book by Giono or Mistral in hand.







ARCHITECTURE

founders of JAUNE

At Capelongue, the architecture, shaped by stone and light, celebrates Provence without freezing it in time, guided by the discerning eye of JAUNE. Architects Marine Delaloy and Paula Alvarez de Toledo sought to create a hotel that honors the soul and heritage of Provence while infusing it with a modern, timeless vision.

«We wanted every element of the project to make sense in relation to the environment and the history of the place. Capelongue, with its exceptional natural setting, required a delicate approach that reveals the beauty of Provençal architecture while reinterpreting it,» explain Marine Delaloy and Paula Alvarez de Toledo. «We aimed to bring even more light and to use natural materials that breathe and converse with the landscape,» they add.

Stone, lime plaster, wood, and terracotta «were chosen for their raw beauty and their ability to absorb the history of the place while bringing a contemporary touch.»

Outside, the gardens redesigned by the Atelier Lamarck also play a crucial role. «We wanted the gardens to be an extension of the hotel, a space where one feels connected to nature.» Vineyards, olive trees, almond trees, rosemary, and lavender create plant alcoves where one can relax in the greenery.

Beyond the architecture, Capelongue offers a sensory experience between art and regional aesthetics. Through carefully chosen elements, the hotel tells the story of Provence while celebrating the beauty of the present moment. The artworks decorating Capelongue are the result of collaborations with local and regional artists, such as Florence Lucchini, a talented ceramist from Terre de Sens; Arsène Welkin, a young self-taught painter from Arles; and Jérémie du Chaffaut, a designer of contemporary Provençal furniture.

To perfect this sensory experience, the music agency Spectre created a custom soundtrack: a sunny playlist inspired by Mediterranean rhythms that accompanies every moment of the day. All these creations dress the hotel with subtle modernity, offering a singular experience, deeply rooted in tradition and resolutely forward-looking.

At La Bastide, Noël Bérard celebrates Provence in its truest and most vibrant form. His instinctive and indulgent cuisine highlights the flavors of the Luberon and Mediterranean influences. He favors bold pairings, like snails paired with carrot and white butter sauce with pastis, or black olive ice cream with chocolate in various textures. More than just a tribute to local products, each dish invites guests to experience the richness of the land, savoring a cuisine where nature and authentic taste always take center stage.



La Bergerie, the wood-fired restaurant by chef Mathieu Guivarch, offers a stunning view of Bonnieux from its open dining room and terrace. La Bergerie invites moments of contemplation, conviviality, and sharing, featuring dishes such as Sisteron lamb leg, Mont Ventoux pig's rib chop, and other freshly seared cuts in the massive fireplace. A true embodiment of Provençal culinary traditions, La Bergerie is the place in the Luberon to share joyful moments with loved ones, from cocktails at aperitif hour to the final glass as the sun sets over the Luberon.

At Capelongue, overlooking Bonnieux, Noël Bérard draws inspiration from the landscapes of the Luberon, where the light, the seasons, and local produce set the rhythm for his cuisine. He observes the surrounding nature, listens to the pace of local producers, and creates honest, minimalist dishes where eaching redient naturally finds its place. Here, there are no embellishments: the essence takes precedence, elevated by meticulous and respectful craftsmanship. Sisteron lamb, bottarga, black olives, and green asparagus become his allies in telling the story of this generous and vibrant Provence.

Originally from Île-de-France, Noël Bérard forged his culinary path through apprenticeshipsat prestigious establishments. From Philippe Mille at Les Crayères in Reims to Maxime Gilbert in Hong Kong, and at the Petit Nice in Marseille, he refined his standards and pursuit of excellence. This international journey shaped his approach, offering him a broader perspective on the craft, balancing rigor with instinct. Returning to France, he joined Édouard Loubet at Capelongue before taking the helm himself, infusing his own culinary identity by blending memories of travels with a deep love for the Provençal terroir.



WELLNESS



The village, known for its two churches, invites visitors to wander through its alleys, stroll along its ramparts, and discover, at every turn, increasingly stunning views of the Luberon.
